Marshmallow Fudge

Ingredients

- 1 1/3 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 2/3 cup fat-free sweetened condensed milk
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 1/3 cups miniature marshmallows
- 2 whole reduced-fat graham crackers, broken into bitesize pieces

Directions

Line an 8 in. Square pan with foil and coat with cooking spray; set aside. In a small heavy saucepan over low heat, melt chocolate chips with milk; stir until smooth. Remove from the heat; cool for 2 minutes. Stir in vanilla. Fold in marshmallows and graham crackers. Pour into prepared pan. Refrigerate for 1 hour or until firm. Using foil lift fudge out of pan. Discard foil; cut into 12 pieces.
