BAKING CORNER

Fossil Cookies

Food-safe plastic insects are needed for this recipe to make the impression of the fossils. They can be purchased at any craft store (AC Moore or Michaels).

Ingredients:

- 2 1/4 cups all purpose flour, plus more for dusting
- Salt
- 2 sticks unsalted butter, room temperature
- 3/4 cup plus 2 tbsp confectioners' sugar
- 1 tsp pure vanilla extract

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- 2. Whisk flour with 1/2 tsp salt in a bowl.
- 3. Beat butter, sugar and vanilla with a mixer on high speed until pale and fluffy. Reduce speed to low.
- 4. Divide dough into 18 1 1/2-inch balls and press into irregular stone shapes using the palm of your hand. Transfer to a parchment lined baking sheet. Dust food-safe plastic insects with flour to coat; press into dough to make fossil impressions. Freeze until dough is very firm, 20 to 30 minutes.
- 5. Bake until golden brown and firm in center, 25 to 28 minutes. Transfer sheet to a wire rack and let cool.

Yields 16 cookies
