Cooking Corner BAKED FUNNEL CAKES

Ingredients:

- 1 cup water
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 4 eggs
- 2 tbsp powdered sugar



Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400° F. Coat a very large baking sheet with cooking spray; place a wire rack over waxed paper or a large tray. Set aside.
- 2. In a medium saucepan, combine the water, butter and salt. Bring to a boil. Add flour all at once, stirring vigorously. Cook and stir until mixture forms a ball. Remove from heat. Cool for 10 minutes. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well with a wooden spoon after AHH-MAY-ZING time. Michael Cederbaum and Jacob each addition.
- 3. Spoon dough into a large resealable plastic bag. Using enjoyed Tennis. scissors, snip a 1/4- to 1/2-inch hole in one corner of the bag. Pipe dough into twelve 3- to 4-inch circles on prepared baking sheet. Fill in the circles with dough swirls and crisscrosses to resemble funnel cakes.
- 4. Bake about 20 minutes or until puffed and golden brown. Transfer to the wire rack. Sift powdered sugar over warm cakes. Serve warm.

BAKING CORNER

Cinnamon Roll French Toast

Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup Butter, melted
- 2 cans (12.4 oz each) Pilsbury refrigerated cinnamon rolls with icing
- 6 Eggs
- 1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
- 2 tsp ground cinnamon
- 2 tsp vanilla
- 1 cup maple syrup (garnish)
- Icing from cinnamon rolls
- Powdered sugar
- 1/2 cup maple syrup, if desired

Directions:

- 1. Heat oven to 375° F. Pour melted butter into ungreased 13x9 inch (3 quart) glass baking dish. Separate both cans of dough into 16 rolls; set icing aside. Cut each roll into 8 pieces; place pieces over butter in dish.
- 2. In medium bowl, beat eggs. Beat in cream, cinnamon and vanilla until well blended. Gently pour over roll pieces.
- 3. Drizzle with 1 cup syrup.
- 4. Bake 20-28 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 15 minutes. Meanwhile, remove covers from icing; microwave on Medium (50%) 10-15 seconds or until thin enough drizzle.
- 5. Drizzle icing over top; sprinkle with powdered sugar. If desired, spoon syrup from dish over individual servings. Serve with the additional 1/2 cup maple syrup.
