BAKING CORNER

MINT CHOCOLATE CHIP CHEESE BALL

Ingredients:

- 8 oz cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup butter, softened
- 1½ cups powdered sugar
- 1½ tsp mint extract
- green gel food coloring
- 2 cups mini chocolate chips, divided
- animal crackers, graham crackers
- wafers to serve with

Instructions:

- Blend cream cheese and butter together.
- Gradually beat in powdered sugar.
- Beat in extract and food coloring until desired color is reached.
- Stir in one cup of mini chocolate chips.
- Transfer to a bowl and refrigerate for 1 hour
- Sprinkle ½ cup of mini chocolate chips on top of a piece of plastic wrap.
- Scoop cream cheese mixture and place on top of chocolate chips. Sprinkle with additional chocolate chips.
- Wrap cheese ball with plastic wrap and place in a clean bowl. Press into bowl to form the cheese ball.
- Invert onto a serving board or cake stand.
- Serve immediately or refrigerate until ready to serve.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.


All food is baked and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Nut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts.

Cooking Corner

Funfetti Rice Krispy Treats

Prep time: 5 mins
Cook time: 5 mins
Total time: 10 mins

Makes : 16 bars
Ingredients:

- 4 tablespoons butter, unsalted
- 12 ounce bag of mini marshmallows
- 4 cups rice krispy cereal
- 1 cup of funfetti sprinkles

Instructions:

- Lightly grease a 9x13 baking dish.
- In a large skillet, combine the butter and marshmallows on medium heat. Keep stirring until the marshmallows are completely melted.
- In a large mixing bowl, add the rice krispy cereal. When the marshmallows are completely melted, stir that into the cereal. Gently fold in the sprinkles.
- Spread the mixture into the baking dish and gently pat down - make sure it is even all around.

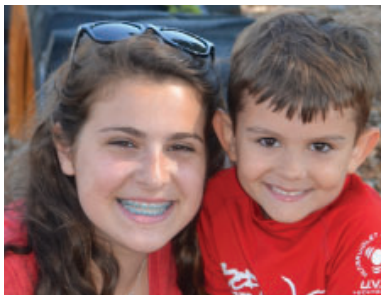
Notes

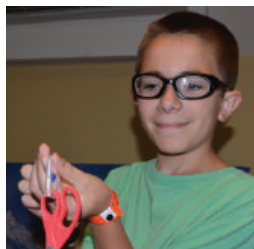
When at First We Don't Succeed, We Try Again in S.T.E.M.

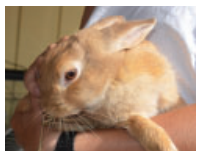
