

## OVERNIGHT TRIP TO BOSTON

Only 5 spots are left on the bus!!! The ELDC 6th-10th grade campers are on the road again for another fantastic 3 day, 2 night trip exploring the sights and sounds of Boston. We'll travel by coach bus to exciting locations such as Fenway Park, Quincy Market and Old Salem. We'll start with lunch in Manchester, then head to Historic Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall. Night one starts with dinner at the Hard Rock Cafe and ends with a sunset cruise through the Boston Harbor.
