WHAT TO BRING & LEAVE AT CAMP

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

Cooking hit the ground running this week with Crescents! All of our recipes included our key ingredient, yummy crescent rolls. You would be amazed at just how much you can do with these rolls as we have made everything from strawberry cheesecake pop tarts to pizza cupcakes! We're so excited to say that next week will be Parfait Week here in cooking.

LEMON CHEESECAKE CRESCENT RING

Ingredients:

6 oz cream cheese, softened
1/4 cup granulated sugar
2 tablespoons lemon juice
1 can of refrigerated crescent dough



Instructions:

1. Heat oven to 375°F. Line cookie sheet with cooking parchment paper.
2. In medium bowl, mix cream cheese, granulated sugar and lemon juice until well mixed and smooth
3. Unroll dough on work surface into rectangle, and cut into 8 rectangles. Spread 2 tablespoons of the cream cheese mixture over each dough rectangle.
4. Roll up each rectangle, starting with shortest side, and pinch seam to seal. Place on cookie sheet, seam side down. Bake 11 to 14 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 10 minutes on cookie sheet.

S'MORES BARS

Everyone had a blast in Baking this week with Donna and Assistant Courtney! Here's one of our favorite recipes from the week!

Ingredients:

For the Graham Base:

- 3 cups graham cracker crumbs (from 18 whole graham crackers)
- ½ cup (99 grams) light brown sugar
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 14 tablespoons (198 grams) unsalted butter, melted

For the Chocolate Layer:

- 12 ounces milk chocolate, finely chopped
- 1(14-ounce) can sweetened condensed milk

For the Marshmallow Layer:

- 36 full-size marshmallows (about one 10-ounce bag)

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Line an 8•8 baking pan with foil and spray foil with non-stick cooking spray.
2. Make the Graham Base: In a medium bowl, stir together the graham cracker crumbs, brown sugar, salt and melted butter until all of the crumbs are evenly moistened. Turn out into the prepared baking pan and press evenly into a tight, compact layer. Bake until it is lightly browned and has a faint toasted smell, about 10 minutes. Remove from the oven.
3. Make the Chocolate: Place the chocolate and sweetened condensed milk in a heatproof bowl set over a small pan of barely simmering water. Stir occasionally until it is completely melted and smooth. Immediately pour it over the graham cracker crust and spread into an even layer.
4. Immediately place the marshmallows on top of the chocolate layer, pressing down slightly to nestle them into the chocolate. When ready to serve, turn on your oven's broiler and place the pan on the center rack. Broil until the marshmallows are puffed and browned, 1 to 2 minutes. Remove from the oven and let cool briefly, then slice and a serve.
