A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats.




The B5A Fireballs

Caramel Pretzel Chocolate Chip Cookies

This cookie was a huge hit with campers to make and eat! Counselors and staff agreed that they are delicious and were rated as a Barry Favorite! This recipe was also made with crumbled graham crackers as a replacement for the caramel and were just as good! Check it out! We believe this could end up in your home recipe collection too!

Ingredients:

1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, room temperature 1/4 cup plus 2 Tbsp sugar 1/4 cup plus 2 Tbsp brown sugar 1/2 tsp vanilla 1 egg 1/2 tsp salt



1 and a half cups flour 3/4 cup stick pretzels, broken into thirds 1/2 cup caramel bits 1/2 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips

Instructions:

1/2 tsp baking soda


In a stand mixer, cream butter with sugars. Add vanilla & egg. Incorporate & scrape bowl.

Combine salt, baking soda and flour. Gradually add to wet mixture. Mix until combined.

Fold in broken pretzels, caramel bits and chocolate chips with a spatula .

Spoon onto a baking sheet with parchment paper. Bake at 350°F for 11-12 minutes.
