A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

Cooking is Mystery Week! Here is a recipe for one of this week's favorite recipes:

Ingredients:

Vegetable cooking spray

- 3 tablespoons plain dry bread crumbs
- 1 teaspoon butter, melted
- 1 can Campbell's Condensed Cheddar Cheese Soup
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1/8 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 2 cups rotini or medium shell-shaped pasta, cooked and drained
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

Instructions:

1. Heat the oven to 400 degrees F. Spray 8 (2 1/2-inch) muffin-pan cups with the cooking spray and lightly coat with 1 tablespoon bread crumbs. Stir the remaining bread crumbs and the butter in a small bowl.

2. Stir the soup, milk, black pepper, rotini and 3/4 cup cheese in a medium bowl. Spoon about 1/3 cup rotini mixture into each muffin-pan cup. Sprinkle with the remaining cheese and bread crumb mixture.

3. Bake for 20 minutes or until the rotini mixture is hot and bubbling. Let stand for 10 minutes before removing the minis from the pan.

Cake Pops!

Ingredients:

- Chocolate Cake, prepared
- 2 heaping spoonfuls of Chocolate Frosting
- 2 boxes Premium white chocolate candy melts
- Cake pop sticks
- Sprinkles

Directions:

1. Add cake to a large bowl and crumble until it resembles fine crumbs

2. Add in frosting a little bit at a time until cake is moist and can hold a ball shape, yet still slightly crumbly.

3. Use your hands to incorporate the frosting into the cake crumbs.

4. Scoop out two balls of cake mixture.

5. Roll the mixture into a tight ball and place on a plate; repeat until all the cake mixture has been rolled into balls.6. Melt 2-4 ounces of white chocolate in the microwave; then dip the tip of the cake pop sticks into the white chocolate and insert into the cake balls about half-way.7. Freeze for about 20 minutes.

8. Meanwhile prepare all of your decorating supplies by melting the remaining chocolate in a large cup. Make sure you have enough chocolate to completely submerge the cake ball.

9. Remove cake balls from freezer; then, dip cake balls carefully into the chocolate until covered.

10. Let the excess chocolate drip off. Swirl and tap gently if needed.

11. Add the sprinkles while the chocolate is still wet. It will harden quickly.

12. Stick the decorated cake pop into a styrofoam block to finish setting; then, place into the freezer to speed up setting time.

13. Cover with a clear treat bag & ribbon for gift giving, if desired.

14. Store in a cool area in a single layer, in an airtight container.

15. Enjoy!
