Cookies n' Cream Rice Krispies

A way to add variety to your rice krispy treats is addins. In this case, you would add Oreo cookies. Feel free to use other favorite cereals to create even more flavors.

Ingredients:

- 3 Tbsp. butter or margarine
- 1 pkg. (10 oz.) JET-PÜFFED Marshmallows
- 5 cups KELLOGG'S® RICE KRISPIES® cereal
- 16 OREO Cookies, coarsely chopped, divided

Directions:

1. Microwave butter in large

microwaveable bowl on HIGH 45 sec. or until melted. Add marshmallows; toss to coat. Microwave 1-1/2 min. or until marshmallows are completely melted and mixture is well blended, stirring after 45 sec.

2. Add cereal and 1 cup chopped cookies; mix well. Press onto bottom of 13x9-inch pan sprayed with cooking spray. Sprinkle with remaining chopped cookies; press lightly into cereal mixture to secure. Cool completely before cutting into squares.
