Tuna, turkey or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats.







COOking

We had a great week cooking up a storm! Check out the recipe below:

FOURTH OF JULY CHEESE QUESADILLA STARS

Ingredients

- butter
- tortillas, taco or burrito size
- shredded cheese, cheddar or Mexican mix
- sour cream
- taco sauce, mild or medium

Instructions

1.Heat small amount of butter in skillet or griddle on medium-low heat.

2.Place tortilla in skillet and cover with shredded cheese.

3.Cover with another tortilla and cook until cheese melts and bottom is crispy.

4.Flip quesadilla over with a spatula and cook until bottom is crispy.

5. While quesadilla cooks, fill one small ziploc bag with sour cream and a second bag with taco sauce. Clip a very small hole in one bottom corner of each bag so they can be used like pastry bags.

6.Remove quesa dilla from skillet and let cool for 1 minute.

7.Using a large star-shaped cookie cutter, cut out stars from the quesadilla.

8.Decorate quesadilla stars by piping sour cream stripes first, and then taco sauce stripes in between the sour cream stripes.

Alternative decoration: Using a star-shaped stencil, make a sour cream or taco sauce star in the center of each quesadilla star.

Another alternative decoration: Spread taco sauce thinly over entire quesadilla star and top with small dollop of sour cream in center. Also may spread sour cream over quesadilla star and top with small dollop of taco sauce.

TRIBAL HISTORY

Eldings (Water)
