Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

SWEET WATERMELON PIZZA

We had a great week in Cooking making different kinds of Pizza. Here is a recipe from one of our favorites:

Prep time 10 mins Total time 10 mins Serves: 4 to 8 servings



INGREDIENTS:

- 1 watermelon, cut into 1-inch thick round slices
- Dairy-Free Greek-style yogurt or coconut cream Shredded or flaked coconut (optionally toasted) Blackberries
- Blueberries
- Strawberries, sliced
- Slivered almonds (omit for nut-free)
- Fresh mint (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Lay a watermelon slice cut side down on a cutting surface. Spread the yogurt or coconut cream to cover the fleshy part of watermelon, leaving room to hold each slice by the rind.

2. Sprinkle with the coconut, berries, and almonds. Optionally garnish with fresh mint.

3. Cut the watermelon into 6 to 8 slices to serve.

4. Repeat with remaining watermelon slices to make as many fruit pizzas as desired.

Puppy Chow

Having recipes handy that don't require an oven make summer treats much easier to make. This week in Baking, we didn't turn our oven on once! It is a delicious, easy to make dessert that everybody loves! Enjoy our recipe for our yummy Cookies and Cream Puppy Chow!

INGREDIENTS:

"Cream" Puppy Chow:

- 5 C. rice chex cereal
- 1 C. white chocolate melts or chocolate chips
- 8 Oreos finely crushed
- 1/2 C. powdered sugar

"Cookies" Puppy Chow:

- 5 C. rice chex cereal
- 1 C. milk chocolate melts or chocolate chips
- 8 Oreos finely crushed
- 1/2 C. powdered sugar
- Extra chopped Oreos

DIRECTIONS:

1. "Cream" Puppy Chow: Measure out rice chex cereal and place in a large bowl.

2. Measure out powdered sugar and crushed Oreos and place in a large plastic bag or in a large tupperware with a lid (You'll need to shake the bag/tupperware later).

3. Melt white chocolate and stir until smooth.

4. Pour melted chocolate over rice cereal and stir until coated.

5. Transfer chocolate coated rice cereal into your plastic bag with sugar/cookies. Shake, shake shake until coated.

6. Dump onto a cookie sheet to cool.

7. Repeat steps 1-7 using "Cookies" Puppy Chow ingredients.

8. Once cooled, mix the "Cookies" and "Cream" Puppy Chow together and fold in extra chopped Oreos.
