Tuna, turkey or sunbutter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

## Fruit Salsa with Cinnamon Chips

In Cooking, campers enjoyed different types of fruit in a new way. Salsa was a huge hit! They also enjoyed being able to make chips instead of pulling them out of a bag. Try to make this at home - it was a delicious treat!



### INGREDIENTS:

- 8 oz strawberries (half package)
- 2 kiwis
- 1/2 mango
- 1 tsp fresh lemon juice
- 1 tsp sugar for fruit salsa
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar for Cinnamon Chips
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 6 flour tortillas 6-inch size
- 2 tbsp butter melted
- 1/4 pineapple

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Set aside 2-3 large baking sheets.
2. Wash and cut kiwi, strawberries, pineapple and mango into same size cubes.
3. In a medium bowl, add pineapple, kiwi, strawberry and mango cubes. Add 1 tsp sugar and fresh lemon juice. Mix gently using a wooden spoon.
4. Cover the bowl with plastic wrap. Chill in the fridge until serving.
5. Cut the tortillas into triangles and place them in a large mixing bowl. Add melted butter and toss. Add 1/4 tsp cinnamon and 1/4 cup sugar, tossing until evenly coated.
6. Place pieces onto prepared baking sheets and bake 3 minutes per side, flipping halfway through.
7. Serve the fruit salsa with baked cinnamon sugar chips and enjoy!

# Fruity Pebbles Cupcake

Our cupcake tins got lots of use for cupcakes and muffins week! One of our biggest hits was our fruity pebble cupcake. This cupcake is not only delicious, but it's colorful and fun too!

## INGREDIENTS:

- 3 cups cake flour
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 cup milk
- 4 egg whites
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 3/4 cup unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup rainbow jimmies

## FOR THE VANILLA BUTTERCREAM FROSTING:

- 1 1/2 cups unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 3 1/2 cups confectioners sugar
- 2 tablespoons heavy cream
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- Fruity Pebbles, for sprinkling

## DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Line a 12-cup standard muffin tin with paper liners; set aside.
2. In a large bowl, combine flour, baking powder and salt.
3. In a medium bowl, whisk together milk, egg whites and vanilla.
4. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with paddle attachment, beat butter and sugar on medium speed until light and fluffy, about 2-3 minutes. With mixer on low speed, add dry ingredients and milk mixture alternately in 3 parts, beginning and ending with dry ingredients, beating just until incorporated. Add rainbow jimmies and stir using a rubber spatula just until moist.
5. Scoop the batter evenly into the muffin tray. Place into oven and bake for 15-18 minutes or until a tester inserted in center comes out clean. Remove from oven and cool completely on a wire rack before frosting.
6. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, beat butter and confectioners' sugar on medium speed until light and fluffy, approximately 1-2 minutes. With the mixer on low speed, gradually add heavy cream and vanilla, beating just until incorporated. Increase speed to medium high and beat until frosting is light and fluffy, approximately 1-2 minutes.
7. Use a small offset spatula or a pastry bag fitted with a decorative tip to frost cupcakes, garnished with Fruity Pebbles, if desired.

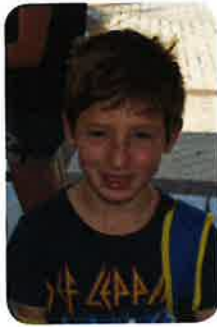

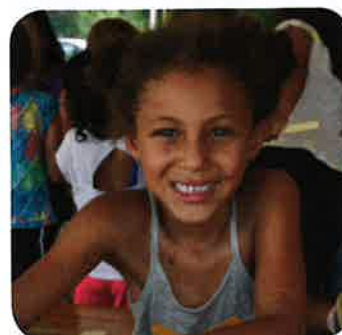
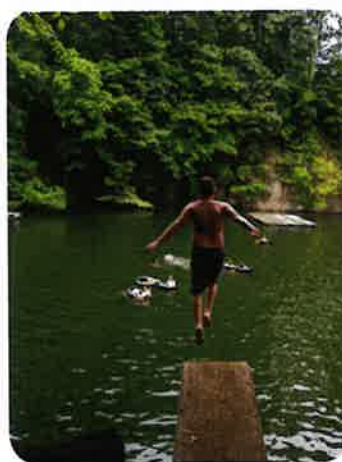
