Our salad bar includes fresh mixed greens, broccoli, tomatoes, cucumbers, carrot sticks, hard boiled eggs, croutons, sliced beets, chunk tuna, hummus, raisins, fresh fruit, applesauce, shredded cheddar cheese, low-fat fruit yogurt, pasta salad and corn.

Tuna, turkey or sunbutter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

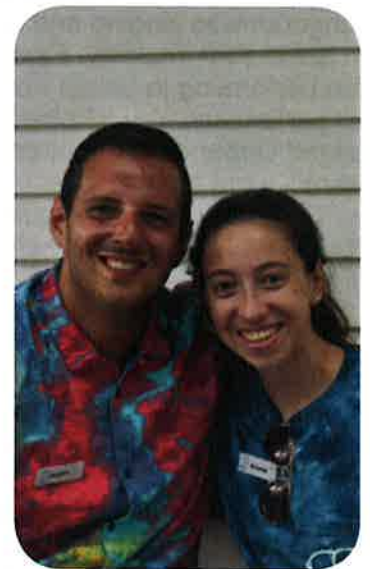

Crescent Dogs

INGREDIENTS:

- 8 hot dogs
- 4 slices (3/4 oz each) American cheese, each cut into 6 strips
- 1 can (8 oz) Pillsbury™ refrigerated crescent dinner rolls



DIRECTIONS:

- 1) Heat oven to 375°F. Slit hot dogs to within 1/2 inch of ends; insert 3 strips of cheese into each slit.
- 2) Separate dough into triangles. Wrap dough triangle around each hot dog. Place on ungreased cookie sheet, cheese side up.
- 3) Bake for 12 to 15 minutes or until golden brown.

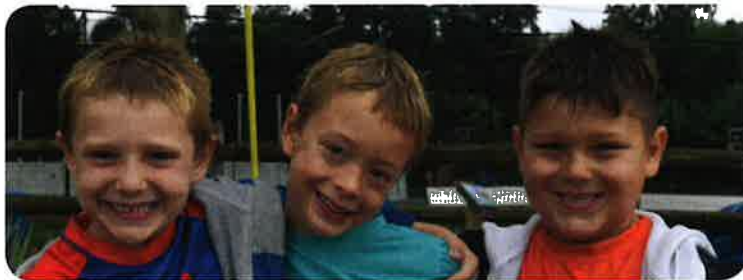

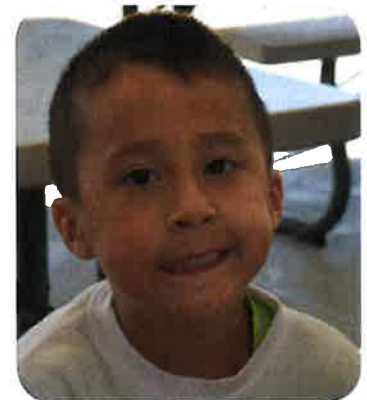

Cake Pops!

Cake pop week was absolutely delicious! All of our campers loved the treats that we made. Our favorite was the Strawberry Shortcake Cake Pops! Try this fantastic recipe at home!

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 prepared pound cake crumbled (a little more than 2 c.)
- 3/4 c. Betty Crocker "Whipped" Whipped Cream Frosting
- 6-8 large strawberries 1 c. chopped
- 2 c. white chocolate melted
- Lollipop sticks



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Mix pound cake, frosting and strawberries together in a medium bowl.
2. Roll into 1 1/2 inch balls.
3. Cut or break lollipop sticks in half; twist 1 stick into the center of each cake ball, about halfway in.
4. Freeze until firm.
5. Dip pops in melted white chocolate to cover.
6. Chill until ready to serve.

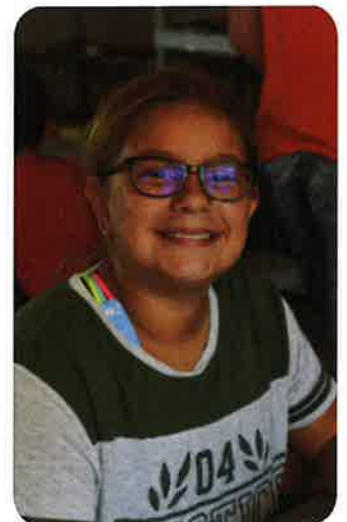
