RICE KRISPY TREATS

Try our basic cereal treat recipe at home and feel free to add in your favorite mix-ins! We recommend sprinkles, Oreos, or chocolate candies as our favorite mix-ins. Have a fantastic school year and we'll see you next summer for more desserts!



INGREDIENTS:

- 3 tablespoons butter
- 1 package (10 oz., about 40) JET-PUFFED Marshmallows
- 6 cups Kellogg's® Rice Krispies® cereal

DIRECTIONS:

1. In a large saucepan melt butter over low heat. Add marshmallows and stir until completely melted. Remove from heat.
2. Add KELLOGG'S RICE KRISPIES cereal. Stir until well coated.
3. Using buttered spatula or wax paper evenly press mixture into 13 x 9 x 2-inch pan coated with cooking spray. Cool. Cut into 2-inch squares. Best if served the same day.

MICROWAVE DIRECTIONS:

In microwave-safe bowl, heat butter and marshmallows on HIGH for 3 minutes, stirring after 2 minutes. Stir until smooth. Follow steps 2 and 3 above. Microwave cooking times may vary.

SMORE'S EMPANADAS

We had a great time in Cooking making Empanadas!

INGREDIENTS: (makes a dozen)

- 1 pie crust sheet
- 2 inch circle cookie cutter
- flour for dusting
- Mini marshmallows (3 per empanada)
- NESTLÉ® TOLL HOUSE® Milk Chocolate Morsels (6 per empanada)
- 1 egg (beaten)



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees. Defrost one pie sheet according to package. Roll out the pie sheet on a floured surface and use a 2 inch circle cookie cutter to cut.
2. Combine leftover dough and roll out again for more circles.
3. Fold the circles in half and close by crimping the ends with a fork.
4. Beat an egg and brush the tops with the egg wash.
5. Bake at 450 degrees for 10 minutes or until the pie crust is golden brown.
