A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

## FROZEN BANANA CEREAL POPS

- 3/4 cup strawberry yogurt
- 2 cups Fruity Pebbles cereal
- 4 medium bananas, peeled and cut crosswise in half
- 8 wooden pop sticks



1. Place yogurt and cereal in separate shallow bowls. Insert pop sticks through cut side of bananas. Dip bananas in yogurt, then roll in cereal to coat. Transfer to waxed paper-lined baking sheets.

2. Freeze until firm, about an hour. Transfer to airtight freezer containers; seal containers and return pops to freezer.

## Can't Leave Alone Bars

- 1 package white cake mix (Regular size)
- 2 large eggs, room temperature
- 1/3 cup canola oil
- 1 can (14 ounces) sweetened condensed milk
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 1/4 cup butter, cubed



1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl, combine the cake mix, eggs, and oil. Press two-thirds of the mixture into a greased 13x9 in baking pan. Set remaining cake mixture aside.
2. In a microwave-safe bowl, combine the milk, chocolate chips, and butter. Microwave, uncovered, until chips and butter are melted; stir until smooth. Pour over crust.
3. Drop teaspoons of remaining cake mixture over top. Bake until lightly browned, 20-25 minutes. Cool before cutting.
