INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup ricotta
- 8 oz cream cheese, room temperature
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 2/3 cup mini chocolate chips
- Waffle cones, broken up

DIRECTIONS:

1. Using a stand or hand mixer and a large bowl, add in ricotta, cream cheese, and powdered sugar on mediumhigh speed until smooth, about 3-5 minutes. Add in vanilla extract and whip for another 30 seconds.

Cannoli Dip

2. Taste test the dip - if you'd like it sweeter, add more powdered sugar, about 2 tablespoons at a time. You can safely add up to another 1/2 cup of powdered sugar (8 tablespoons) without negatively impacting consistency.

3. Fold in mini chocolate chips, reserving some to sprinkle on top for decoration if desired.

4. Serve dip immediately with broken waffle cones for dipping.

Apple-Cinnamon Wontons

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 medium apples, McIntosh, peeled, cored and minced

- 1 tablespoon packed light brown sugar

- 1 teaspoon fresh lemon juice
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 24 wonton wrappers

- 1 1/2 tablespoons powdered sugar

DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Coat a large baking sheet with butter flavored cooking spray.

2. In a medium bowl, combine apples, brown sugar, lemon juice and cinnamon; toss to coat apples.

3. Place wonton wrappers on a flat surface. Drop apple mixture by teaspoonfuls onto center of each wrapper. Moisten edges of wrapper with wet fingers, fold over one corner to make a trioangle and press sides together to seal. Transfer filled wrappers to prepared baking sheet and coat surface with cooking spray.

4. Bake until wontons are golden brown, about 15 minutes. Place wontons on individual plates and sift with powdered sugar. Serve with ice cream on the side.




B5A Wraps Up the Summer
