A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

Cookies and Cream Cookies

Ingredients:

- 1 cup butter softened
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 4.2 oz pkg Oreo Cookies & Cream pudding mix
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 1/4 cups flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 cup white chocolate chips
- 15 Oreo cookies coarsely crushed (you want big chunks!)

Instructions:

- 1. Cream the butter and sugars. Add the pudding mix and mix until well blended. Add the eggs and vanilla and mix well. Add the flour and baking soda and continue mixing.
- 2. Stir in the white chocolate chips and Oreo cookie chunks.
- 3. Drop cookies by rounded teaspoonfuls onto a greased cookie sheet.

Bake for 10 minutes at 350. Enjoy!

S'MORES POPCORN BALLS

These were delicious! Hope you enjoy them too!

Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- ½ cup unpopped popcorn
- 1 cup of Golden Grahams cereal
- 1/4 cup of Chocolate chips
- 6 tablespoons butter
- 5 cups miniature marshmallows

Directions

- 1. Grease a 9x13 inch baking dish. Set aside.
- 2. Add vegetable oil to a 4 quart saucepan, and heat over high heat. When oil is hot, add popping corn. Keep pan moving constantly. When corn stops popping, remove from heat. Put popcorn in prepared pan.
- 3. Melt butter In a medium saucepan over low heat. Stir in marshmallows and cook until melted, stirring constantly. Pour marshmallow mixture over popcorn, cereal, and chocolate chips and mix with spoon to coat evenly.
- 4. Let mixture cool slightly. Smear butter on your hands or spray with non-stick cooking spray. Mix popcorn with your hands so that it is evenly coated.
- 5. Form popcorn into 8 balls.
