What to Bring and Leave at Camp

Please send the following items with your child every day in their backpack with their name clearly written on it (all items besides water shoes and sunscreen must go home daily):

- two bathing suits (wear one to camp)
- sunscreen (spray preferred with a stick for the face)
- underwear

- refillable water bottle

- swim goggles (our pools are salt water to reduce sensitivity)
- a complete change of clothing including underwear, socks, t-shirt, shorts, and water shoes

Please apply sunscreen to your camper each morning. Counselors in grades KK through 5 will automatically reapply sunscreen to campers after swim.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

STEM

We were magnetically attracted to ELDC for another amazing summer! Grades 3 and 4 made electromagnets! They learned that by wrapping a copper wire around an iron nail and taping it to a battery would magnetize their iron nail and they can pick up paper clips (but be careful, the copper wire gets hot). Grades 5 and 6 learned about the strength of an electromagnet by wrapping a magnetic wire around an iron bolt and attaching each side of the wire by alligator clips (after sanding it) to the lantern battery! The more the magnetic wire is wrapped around, the stronger magnetic force it will have. Some groups picked up paper clips with their iron bolt. In Grades 7-LIT's, they created their own magnetic mazes and it was awesome to see how artistic and unique some of them turned out. Electives in Grades 5 and 6 discovered magnetic field patterns using iron filings and made magnetic slime. Electives in Grades 7 and 8 were to make simple motors and to make magnetic slime. During Week 2, we played with air pressure. Grades 3 and 4 got to use air pressure in different ways. Grades 5 and 6 had a chance to see how air force is used in transportation. Grades 7, 8, and LIT's had a challenge to build a Windmill using supplies given. It was awesome to see their minds at work.

Chocolate Ganache Cupcakes

Ingredients:

- 1/4 pound unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 1 cup sugar
- 4 extra-large eggs, at room temperature
- 1 1/3 cups Hershey's chocolate syrup
- 1 tablespoon pure vanilla extract
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon instant coffee granules



For the ganache:

- 1/2 cup heavy cream
- 8 ounces good semisweet chocolate chips
- 1/2 teaspoon instant coffee granules

Directions:

1. Preheat the oven to 325 degrees F. Line a muffin pan with paper liners.
2. Cream the butter and sugar in the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment until light and fluffy. Add the eggs, 1 at a time. Mix in the chocolate syrup and vanilla. Add the flour and coffee granules and mix until just combined. Don't overbeat, or the cupcakes will be tough.
3. Scoop the batter into the muffin cups and bake for 30 minutes, or until just set in the middle. Don't overbake! Let cool thoroughly in the muffin pan.
4. For the ganache, cook the heavy cream, chocolate chips, and instant coffee in the top of a double boiler over simmering water until smooth and warm, stirring occasionally.
5. Dip the tops of the cupcakes into the ganache. Do not refrigerate.

Ropes

At Low Ropes, campers have been displaying excellent teamwork and communication skills. CHEESECAKE MOUSSE

INGREDIENTS:

- 2/3 cup heavy whipping cream
- 3/4 cup powdered sugar, divided
- One 8-ounce package cream cheese, at room temperature
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 tablespoons milk

FRUIT:

Your choice - [blueberries](#) work wonderfully

DIRECTIONS:

1. Prepare the cheesecake mousse: In a medium bowl, use an electric mixer to beat the heavy cream until it begins to thicken. While mixing, slowly add 1/4 cup powdered sugar. Continue to beat until the mixture is thickened and holds a stiff peak. Do not overbeat or it will become overly thick and clumpy. Scoop into a bowl and put in the refrigerator.

2. In the empty bowl (no need to wash), add cream cheese and beat until smooth. Continue mixing and add remaining powdered sugar and vanilla. Add milk and beat until well-combined. Stop mixing and use a rubber spatula to gently fold in the cold whipped cream until combined. Use immediately, or cover and keep refrigerated for up to one day.

3. Assemble the cups: Start with fruit in the bottom of each glass or small mason jar. Add a layer of the cheesecake mousse and then repeat with another layer of fruit and another layer of mousse. Continue layering the cheesecake and fruit, depending on the size of your cups and the variety of fruit. Keep refrigerated until ready to serve.
