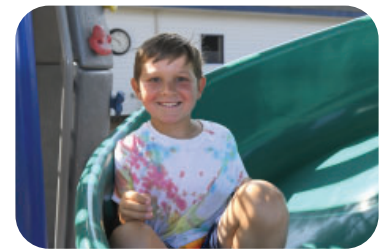
Our salad bar includes fresh mixed greens, broccoli, grape tomatoes, tofu, cucumbers, carrot sticks, hard boiled eggs, pasta salad, croutons, chick peas, farro salad, edamame, chunk tuna, hummus, fresh fruit, applesauce, shredded cheese, non-fat fruit yogurt, pasta salad, corn, and assorted dressings

Tuna, Kosher turkey or Sun Butter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

Muffins

Ingredients:

- 1 and 3/4 cups all-purpose flour (scoop & leveled)
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened to room temperature
- 3/4 cup packed light brown sugar (or granulated)
- 2 large eggs, at room temperature
- 1/2 cup sour cream or plain yogurt, at room temperature
- 1 and 1/2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 1/4 cup milk (any kind), at room temperature

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 F. Spray a 12-count muffin pan with nonstick spray or line with cupcake liners. Set aside. In a large bowl, whisk the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt together. Set aside.
2. In a large bowl using a handheld or stand mixer fitted with a paddle attachment, beat the butter on high speed until smooth and creamy, about 1 minute. Add the brown sugar and beat on high until creamed, about two full minutes. Scrape down the sides and bottom of the bowl as needed. Add the eggs, sour cream, and vanilla extract. Beat on medium speed for 1 minute, then turn up to high speed until the mixture is combined. Scrape down the sides and bottom of the bowl as needed.
3. Pour the dry ingredients into the wet ingredients and beat on low speed until just about combined. Add the milk and continue to beat on low until combined. Fold in add-ins. (See flavors/details in the notes below.)
4. Spoon the batter evenly into each cup or liner, filling each all the way to the top. Bake the muffins for 5 minutes at 425 then, keeping the muffins in the oven, reduce the oven temperature to 350°F. Bake for an additional 15-18 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. The total time these muffins take in the oven is about 22-23 minutes, give or take.
5. Allow the muffins to cool for 5 minutes in the muffin pan, then transfer to a wire rack to continue cooling.

Options

White Chocolate Raspberry Muffins – Fold 1 cup raspberries + 3/4 cup white chocolate chips into the batter as instructed in step 4.

Apple Cinnamon Muffins – Mix an additional 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon with the dry ingredients in step 2. Fold 1 cup peeled chopped apple into the batter as instructed in step 4.

Mixed Berry Muffins – Fold 1 and 1/2 cups mixed berries into the batter as instructed in step 4.

Chocolate Chip Muffins– Fold 1 and 1/2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips into the batter as instructed in step 4.

Blueberry Lemon muffin- Mix 1.5 tsp lemon zest + juice of half lemon in wet mix. Fold 1 cup of fresh or frozen blueberries in the batter as instructed in step 4.

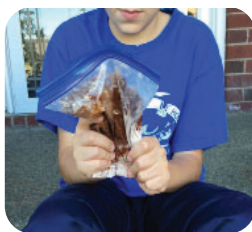
