A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

ZUCCHINI WAFFLE GRILLED CHEESE

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 large zucchini
- 1 large egg
- 1/2 c. freshly grated Parmesan
- 2 green onions, thinly sliced
- 1/4 c. cornstarch
- Kosher salt
- Black pepper
- 1/2 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes
- 2 c. shredded Cheddar

DIRECTIONS:

1. Grate zucchini on a box grater, then squeeze excess moisture with a clean kitchen towel.
2. In a large bowl, mix grated zucchini, egg, Parmesan, green onions, and cornstarch. Season with salt, pepper, and red pepper flakes.
3. Heat a waffle iron and pour in 1/3 cup of zucchini mixture. Cook until golden, about 3 minutes. Continue with the rest of mixture.
4. Place one waffle back into the waffle iron and top with 1/2 cup cheese. Top with another waffle and cook until cheese is melted. Repeat with remaining waffles and cheese.

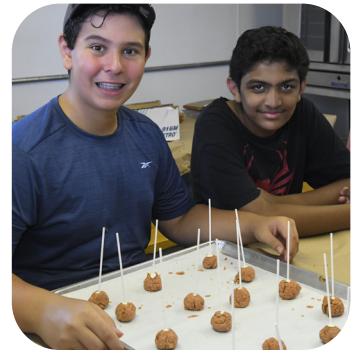

Cake Balls Recipe

A recipe for cake balls that uses cake mix, frosting and candy melts to create fun and festive bites. Cake balls are perfect for gift giving and they’re easy to turn into cake.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 box cake mix flavor of your choice
- Eggs, oil and water as called for on cake mix box
- 1 cup + 2 tablespoons canned frosting flavor of your choice
- 1 pound candy melts
- Wafers
- 1/2 cup sprinkles

INSTRUCTIONS

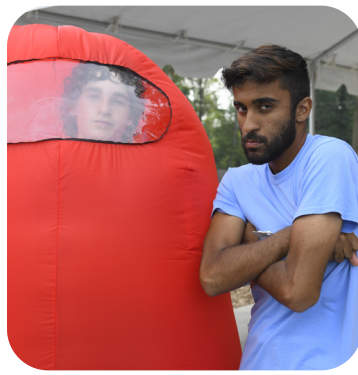
1. Prepare cake mix with the amount of oil, water and eggs directed on the box. Bake in a 9”x13” pan according to package directions.
2. Let cake cool completely, then break apart and crumble until fine crumbs form.
3. Stir in the frosting until a dough forms. If the dough seems dry, you can add additional frosting, 1 tablespoon at a time, until desired consistency is reached.
4. Roll the cake mixture into tablespoon sized balls. Place the balls on a parchment lined baking sheet and chill for at least one hour.
5. Melt the candy melts in a bowl in the microwave, heating in 30 second increments, and stir until completely smooth.
6. Place each cake ball on a fork and use a spoon to pour the candy melts over the cake ball. Tap against the side of the bowl to remove excess candy melts.
7. Place each ball on a parchment lined sheet pan. Top with sprinkles.
8. Repeat with remaining cake balls and candy melts. Store in the refrigerator until ready to eat. Can be made up to 3 days in advance.

- ~ Lemon cake + lemon frosting
- ~ Spice cake + cream cheese frosting
- ~ Funfetti cake + vanilla frosting
- ~ Chocolate cake mix + chocolate frosting
- ~ Strawberry cake + strawberry frosting
- ~ Red velvet cake + cream cheese frosting
