
B30's adventurous week!

S'MORES FUDGE

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 1/2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 2/3 cup sweetened condensed milk
- 2 tsp vanilla
- 1 1/2 cups mini marshmallows
- 3 whole graham crackers broken into pieces

DIRECTIONS:

1. Combine chocolate chips and condensed milk in a mixing bowl. Microwave for 1 minute 15 seconds. Stir gently until completely melted. Add in vanilla and stir a few more times. Pour in marshmallows and graham crackers and stir just until combined.

2. Transfer to a foil lined 8x8 glass dish. Spread mixture around the pan until fairly even. Refrigerate 2 hours until fully set. Cut into small squares and serve.

3. Once fudge is set, you can store it on the countertop.

CHEWY HONEY GRANOLA BARS

Ingredients:

- 3 cups old-fashioned oats
- 2 cups unsweetened
- puffed wheat cereal
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/3 cup raisins
- 1/3 cup miniature semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup honey
- 1/4 cup butter, melted
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, combine the first 8 ingredients. In a small bowl, combine honey, butter and vanilla; pour over oat mixture and mix well. (Mixture will be sticky.)

2. Press into a 13x9-in. baking pan coated with cooking spray. Bake 14-18 minutes or until set and edges are lightly browned. Cool on a wire rack. Cut into bars.






GKC Rocking Week 6
