Tuna, turkey or sunbutter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

INGREDIENTS:

- 5 cups Cheerios Multi-Grain

- 3 tbsp Butter

- 1/2 cup Caramel Sauce

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Melt the marshmallows and butter over medium-low heat, stirring constantly.
2. Add the Cheerios to a large bowl and pour the melted marshmallow mixture over to coat.
3. Coat all of the Cheerios in the marshmallow mixture and stir in the chocolate chips. (Don't over-stir at this stage or the chocolate will melt.)
4. Transfer the marshmallow cereal to a large pan lined with parchment paper.
5. Sprinkle with more chocolate chips (optional) and drizzle the entire pan with caramel sauce.
6. Allow to cool completely.
7. Cut in to squares and enjoy.

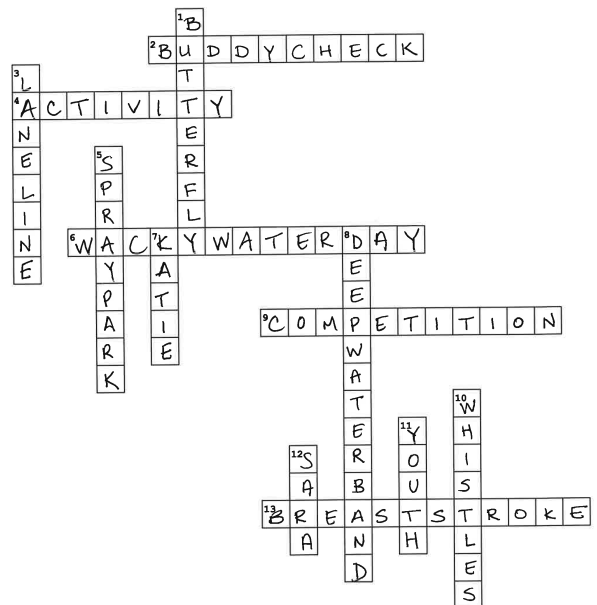

Veggie Lover's Mini Quiche

Ingredients:

- 1 box (14.1 oz) refrigerated Pillsbury™ Pie Crusts (2` Count), softened as directed on box
- 1 container (7.5 oz) chive & onion cream cheese spread
- 4 eggs
- 3 cups fresh baby spinach, chopped (from 5-oz package)
- 1/2 cup chopped red bell pepper
- 1/4 cup sliced green onions
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 cup finely shredded sharp cheddar cheese (4 oz)



Instructions:

1. Heat oven to 425°F. Remove pie crusts from pouches; place flat on work surface. With rolling pin, roll each crust into 12-inch round. With 3 1/2-inch round cookie cutter, cut 22 rounds from crusts, rerolling scraps as necessary. Press 1 round in bottom and up side of each of 22 ungreased regular-size muffin cups. Set aside.

2. In medium bowl, beat cream cheese and eggs with electric mixer on medium speed until smooth and creamy. Stir in spinach, bell pepper, green onions, salt and pepper until well mixed. Stir in cheddar cheese. Spoon 2 tablespoons filling into each crust-lined muffin cup.

3. Bake 13 to 18 minutes or until filling is set and crust is golden brown. Cool in pan 10 minutes. Remove from pan to serving platter. Serve warm. Cover and store leftovers in refrigerator.
