WHAT TO BRING & LEAVE AT CAMP

Please send the following items with your child every day in their backpack:

- · two bathing suits please wear one to camp
- sunscreen
- shorts
- underwear
- two towels
- plastic bag for wet clothing

Campers in grades Kiddie Kingdom through 2nd grade received a bag (which we call a Bundle Bag) to hold their additional items that are kept at camp. Please include the following items:

- sweatshirt or light jacket for chilly days
- bathing suit and flip flops for walking to and from the pool
- sunscreen with bug repellent
- swim goggles (our pools are salt water to reduce sensitivity)
- a complete change for clothing including underwear, socks, t-shirt, shorts and water shoes

Please apply sunscreen to your camper each morning. Counselors in grades KK through 5 will automatically reapply sunscreen to campers after each swim. If you want sunscreen reapplied to an older camper, please send in a note via bus mail.







Oreo and Sun Butter Brownie Cakes

We had an amazing time in Baking this week! Campers really loved this recipe!

Ingredients:

- 1 box Brownie mix
- 24 oreo cookies
- 1/2 cup Sun Butter, creamy

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350(F) degrees and line a 12 muffin cup baker with paper liners.
- 2. Prepare brownie mix according to package directions. For each cupcake cup spread 1 teaspoon of sun butter over 2 Oreo cookies and stack them on top of each other. Place oreo stacks into the cupcake lined muffin cups.
- 3. Spoon 2 tablespoons of brownie batter over each stacked oreos and let it run down the sides of the cookies. If you have left over brownie batter, bake separately in a separate baker or muffin tin.
- 4. Bake cookies and brownies for 18 to 20 minutes, until brownies are cooked through. Let cool completely then serve.

SNICKERDOODLE POPCORN

What a yummy week at Cooking! We enjoyed making Snickerdoodle Popcorn!

Ingredients:

- 2-3 cups of Cinnamon Chex Cereal
- 2-3 cups of Chocolate Chex Cereal
- 1/4 cup of butter (half a stick)
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/4 cup of granulated (white)sugar
- 4 cups (or more) of popped popcorn

Directions:

- 1. Mix the sugar and cinnamon in a bowl and set aside.

- 3. In a microwavable bowl, melt the butter. Pour the butter over the cereal and popcorn mixture to coat evenly.
- 4. Sprinkle the cinnamon and sugar mixture over top and mix well so that everything is evenly coated.

Tuna, turkey or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.



Ladings (Wind)


