SWEET PIZZA TREATS

Ingredients:

- 3 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 1 package (10 oz., about 40) Marshmallows
- 4 cups Miniature
 Marshmallows
- 6 cups Rice Krispies cereal
- 6 cups Cocoa Krispies cereal
- Strawberry jam
- Canned frosting
- Fruit roll-ups, cut into 1 1/4-inch circles
- Multi-colored sprinkles

Directions:

- 1. In large saucepan melt butter over low heat. Add marshmallows and stir until completely melted. Remove from heat.
- 2. Add Rice Krispies cereal. Stir until well coated.
- 3. Using buttered spatula or wax paper evenly press mixture into 12-inch pizza pan coated with cooking spray. Cool.
- 4. Spread strawberry jam on top for "tomato sauce". Carefully spread frosting over jam for "cheese". Add fruit roll-up circles for "pepperoni". Top with sprinkles. Cut into slices to serve.

- 2. Cut cheese sticks into 4 pieces each.
- 3. Separate biscuits and push a cheese section into the middle covering it with the dough.
- 4. Bake for 10 minutes.
- 5. Melt butter in a pan and add spices and parmesan cheese.
- 6. Brush butter mixture on baked biscuits.
- 7. Serve with some marinara sauce for dipping and ENJOY!
