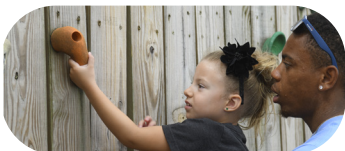

Tuna, Kosher turkey or Sun Butter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

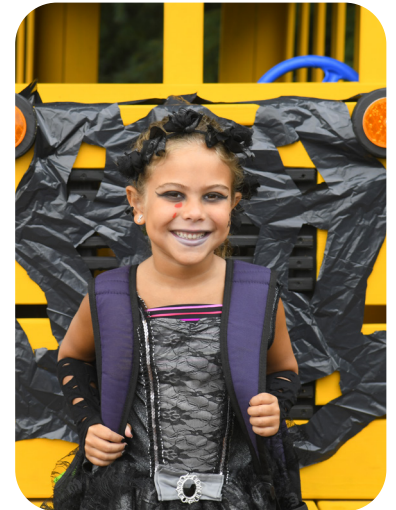
G7A's BEST WEEK EVER

Cinnamon Donut Puffs

Ingredients:

- 1¼ cups plain (all-purpose) flour
- 1½ tsp baking powder
- ⅓ cup caster (superfine) sugar
- 125 g unsalted butter
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- ⅔ cup milk



Cinnamon sugar coating

- ⅓ cup white (granulated) sugar
- ½ tsp ground cinnamon
- 4 tbsp unsalted butter

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to (350°F). Grease non-stick patty tins. Using a sifter or sieve, sift the flour and baking powder into a big bowl. Add the sugar and, using a spoon or spatula, dig a small well in the middle.
2. Place the butter in a small saucepan over low heat, stirring with a spatula, until melted. Break the egg into a medium jug and add the milk and melted butter. Mix to combine, using a whisk. Pour the egg mixture into the well in the flour mixture and whisk until smooth.
3. Divide the mixture between the prepared tins, filling each one just to the top. Bake for 12 minutes or until puffed up and golden brown.
4. To make the cinnamon sugar coating, place the sugar and cinnamon in a medium shallow bowl and mix to combine, using a spatula. Place the butter in a small saucepan over low heat, stirring with the spatula, until melted. Allow to cool a little.
5. Wearing oven gloves, remove the puffs from the oven and allow to cool in the tins for 1 minute.
6. Carefully move the puffs onto a wire rack and, using a pastry brush, brush them all over with the melted butter while they're still hot. Toss them in the cinnamon mixture to coat.
7. Serve the doughnut puffs warm or allow them to cool completely back on the rack.

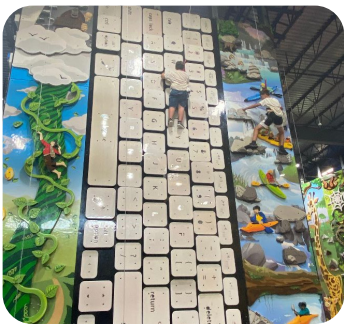


B4B'S BRILLIANT WEEK 5!
