Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled and contains no trans fats. Nothing is fried.

Cookies and Cream Dessert Cups

We had a wonderful summer working with all of the amazing campers. We baked up some delicious treats and lifelong memories.

INGREDIENTS:

Chocolate Cookie Crust

- 2 cups crushed chocolate sandwich cookies
- ¼ cup butter melted Cookies and Cream Filling
- 8 oz cream cheese room temperature
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 ½ cups heavy cream
- ½ cup crushed chocolate sandwich cookies Garnish
- 28 mini chocolate sandwich cookies

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a small bowl, combine 2 cups chocolate sandwich cookie crumbs and melted butter.
- 2. Portion the crumbs into 28 2-ounce plastic cups using a small cookie scoop or spoon. Use one of the plastic cups to press the crumbs into the bottom of the cup.
- 3. In another mixing bowl, combine room temperature cream cheese and granulated sugar. Cream together with an electric hand mixer on medium speed until combined and smooth.
- 4. Add in heavy whipping cream and vanilla extract. Whip on medium-high speed until light and fluffy.
- 5. Fold in ½ cup chocolate sandwich cookie crumbs.
- 6. Fill a piping bag with the cookies and cream mixture. Pipe the mixture into the cups until about 3/4 full.
- 7. Top each dessert cup with a mini chocolate sandwich cookie or additional cookie crumbs.
- 8. Seal the cups with a lid and chill. The cups can be served immediately or stored in the refrigerator for 2-3 days.

GARLIC BUTTER SAUCE AND FRESH PASTA DOUGH

Garlic Butter Sauce

- Kosher salt

column...)

- 1 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- 20 cloves garlic, 18 cloves finely minced and 2 cloves, thinly sliced
- 1/2 c. (1 stick) butter
- Freshly ground black pepper
- Pinch of red pepper flakes
- Fresh parsley, roughly chopped, for garnish
- 1. Add 2 tablespoons salt to a large pot of boiling water. Cook pasta until al dente, about 2 to 3 minutes less than the box instructions. Reserve ¼ cup of pasta water before draining. In a large skillet over medium heat, add oil and heat until shimmering. Add sliced garlic and cook, turning often, until golden brown and crispy. Transfer garlic chips to a paper towel-lined plate.
- 2. Wipe out the skillet and return it over medium-low heat. Melt butter until foamy, then add minced garlic. Cook, stirring or swirling often, until just beginning to turn golden and the garlic begins to smell slightly nutty, about 5 minutes. Remove from the heat and whisk in reserved pasta water. Add pasta and toss to coat. Season with salt, black pepper, and red pepper flakes to taste. Garnish with parsley and serve. (*Continued on next*








Fresh Pasta Dough

- 2 1/4 c. all-purpose flour, plus more for surface
- 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 4 large eggs





- 2. On a lightly floured surface, roll uncovered dough into a long rectangle that's a little less wide than the width of your pasta roller. Set pasta roller to widest setting and pass the rolled out dough through 3 times. Fold short ends of dough to meet in center of rectangle, then fold in half so that the dough is in quarters. Roll pasta dough out so the dough is once again only slightly less wide than the width of your pasta roller. If your dough is springing back too much, cover it with a kitchen towel and let rest 10 minutes. Repeat the rolling and folding process until the dough is very smooth, 3 to 4 more times
- 3. Reduce setting by one degree and run pasta dough through once, then reduce setting by one degree after each run through until you've reached the desired thickness of pasta. About 1/16 of an inch thick for regular pasta and 1/32 for filled pasta. Run the pasta dough through twice on the last desired setting. If your pasta sheet becomes too long to work with, cut it in half. Repeat with remaining dough in refrigerator. Keep rolled out dough covered with a clean kitchen towel.
- 4. Lightly flour 2 large baking sheets. Trim edges of dough to make a clean rectangle and cut pasta into desired shape. (We like 11" long and 1/4" wide for fettuccine-like pasta.) Place pasta on floured baking sheets and cover with a clean kitchen towel. Let dry out for about 30 minutes. To cook: Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Add pasta and cook until al dente, 7 to 9 minutes. Drain and toss with desired sauce.
