Tuna, turkey or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.

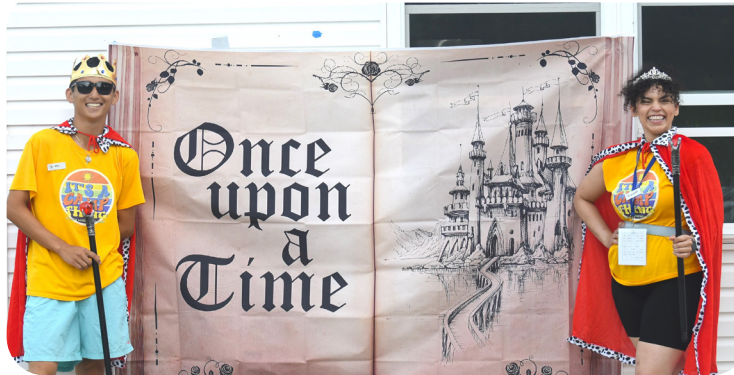

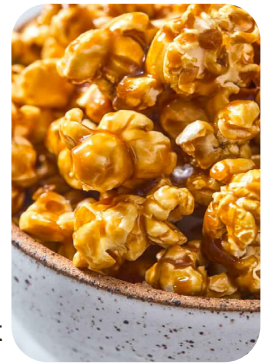
Caramel Popcorn

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups butter cubed
- 2 1/2 cups light brown sugar
- 1 cup golden syrup
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 10 cups popped popcorn

DIRECTIONS:

1. Line two 15x10 inch pans with parchment. In a large saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Add brown sugar and syrup, stirring to dissolve brown sugar. Bring to a full rolling boil. Boil and stir one minute. Remove from heat and quickly stir in vanilla.
2. Pour caramel mixture over popcorn and stir lightly to coat. Using a rubber spatula, press popcorn into prepared pans. Cool. Pull apart into pieces. Enjoy!

CUPCAKES

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour, measured correctly
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1/3 cup natural unsweetened cocoa
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 cup warm coffee, or 8 fluid oz
- 1 Tbsp white distilled vinegar
- 1/3 cup light olive oil or vegetable oil
- 1 large egg, room temperature
- 2 tsp vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350°F with the rack in the center of the oven. Fill a 12-count muffin tin with cupcake liners.
2. In a large mixing bowl, thoroughly whisk together dry ingredients, breaking up most of the cocoa clumps.
3. In a second mixing bowl, whisk together wet ingredients.
4. Pour wet ingredients over dry ingredients and whisk just until the ingredients come together and no dry streaks remain. Batter will be a little loose and lumpy.
5. Use an ice cream scoop to portion batter, filling each cup 2/3 full (do not over-fill). Bake 18-22 min (20 minutes was perfect), until a toothpick inserted in the center, comes out clean.
6. Cool 5 minutes in the pan then transfer to a rack to cool completely to room temperature before frosting.
