What to Bring and Leave at Camp

Please send the following items with your child every day in their backpack. Please clearly print their name on the tag provided on the back of the backpack:

- two bathing suits (wear one to camp)
- shorts
- underwear
- two towels
- plastic bag for wet clothing

We recommend sending in the following items for your camper to leave in their cubby at camp (all labeled with a sharpie!):

- sunscreen
- flip flops for walking to and from the pool. Swim shoes are another option and will protect their feet while in the water.
- swim goggles (optional)
- sweatshirt or light jacket for chilly days

Please apply sunscreen to your camper each morning. Counselors in grades KK through 5 will automatically reapply sunscreen to campers after each swim. If you want sunscreen reapplied to an older camper, send in a note via Bus Mail.

Campers in Kiddie Kingdom will also receive a bag, which we call a *Bundle Bag*, to hold their additional items that stay at camp. This bag will be in your child's backpack. Please include the following items in addition to what will stay in their cubby:

- bathing suit
- extra sunscreen
- a complete change for clothing including underwear, socks, t-shirt, shorts

Our salad bar includes fresh mixed greens, broccoli, grape tomatoes, Tofu, cucumbers, carrot sticks, hard boiled eggs, pasta salad, chick peas, black bean taco salad, farro salad, edamame, chunk tuna, hummus, fresh fruit, applesauce, shredded cheese, non-fat fruit yogurt, pasta salad, corn, and assorted dressings.

Tuna, Kosher turkey or Sun Butter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

Funfetti Goopy Bars

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 box of yellow cake mix
- 1/2 cup of unsalted butter, softened
- 1 large egg
- 2/3 cup of sprinkles
- 1/2 cup of sweetened condensed milk
- 1 cup of white chocolate chips



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Line a 9x9" pan with foil and spray liberally with cooking spray.
2. Add cake mix, butter, and egg to the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with a paddle attachment. (You can also use a hand mixer.) Mix until a thick dough forms. This will take a long time, especially if you're using a hand mixer. Just keep mixing! Add sprinkles and stir until incorporated.
3. Press about 1/2 - 2/3 of the dough into the bottom of the prepared pan. Pour sweetened condensed milk over the top of the dough, leaving a thin border around the edges. Sprinkle with white chocolate chips. Separate remaining dough into small balls and evenly space over the top of the bars. Press down to flatten. Try to seal the edges as much as possible.
4. Bake bars for about 25-30 minutes, or until they just begin to brown. Cool completely before slicing, otherwise the mixture will be too gooey to cut.
