SunButter Sandwich Cookies

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup Natural SunButter
- 1/3 cup maple syrup
- 3/4 cup oat flour (plus extra for rolling)
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/4 tsp salt

Filling:

- 1/4 cup Natural SunButter
- 1 tbsp coconut oil
- 1 tbsp maple syrup

Directions:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350°F.
- 2. Whisk together the SunButter, maple syrup, and vanilla.
- 3. Add the oat flour and salt. Mix to form a thick dough.
- 4. Roll out on a sheet of wax paper, using a light dusting of oat flour as needed (too much will make your cookies dry). You want it pretty thin, less that 1/4 inch if possible.
- Cut into flowers (or any shape) and transfer to a lined baking sheet. If they are hard to transfer, freeze the already rolled/cut dough for 10-15 minutes.
- 6. Bake for 15 minutes at 350°F until the edges are golden brown.
- 7. Cool completely before sandwiching.
- 8. For the filling, stir together all the ingredients and refrigerate for 10-15 minutes to thicken.
- Spoon a dollop of filling on one cookie. Sandwich with another cookie. Refrigerate to "glue" them together and let the filling set completely.
- Enjoy! Keep in the fridge for up to a week in an airtight container. Or you can freeze the cookies (without filling) for longer storage.

Baked Mozzarella Sticks

INGREDIENTS:

- 5 slices of whole-grain bread
- 2 tablespoons Parmesan cheese, grated
- 2 tablespoons Olive oil
- 1/2 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- 1 large egg
- 1/4 cup flour
- 8 sticks of string cheese

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375F.
- 2. Place the frozen bread in a blender or food processor and pulse until uniform medium crumbs form.
- 3. Stir in cheese, olive oil, and Italian seasonings.
- 4. Place the breadcrumb mixture in a small but wide dish. In another dish, add the egg, fork-whisked with a tablespoon of water. In a third dish, place the flour.
- 5. Unwrap the cheese sticks, and roll each one first in the flour, then the egg, then the breadcrumbs. Make sure each stick is well coated, then place it on a greased cookie sheet.
- 6. Bake 6 to 8 minutes, checking frequently, until cheese is just melted but not too runny.
- 7. Serve hot with marinara sauce for dipping.
