Tuna, Kosher turkey, or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

3. Add spinach into the cream cheese mixture and stir.
4. Unroll puff pastry sheets and brush both sides with egg and water mixture.
5. Spread cream cheese and spinach mixture over one side of the puff pastry.
6. Roll up the puff pastry and slice.
7. Place rolls on a baking sheet and bake at 400° for 20 minutes or until the puff pastry turns a golden color.

VANILLA GLAZED BAKED DONUTS

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup of all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1 teaspoon of baking powder
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter melted
- 1 egg
- 1/3 cup + 1/2 tablespoon skim milk
- teaspoon vanilla extract



For the vanilla glaze:

- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 small pinch of salt
- 1 or 2 tablespoons milk

DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
2. Spray donut pan with nonstick cooking spray and set aside.
3. In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, sugar, baking powder and salt.
4. In a small bowl, whisk together egg, milk, butter and vanilla extract.
5. Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and stir together until no flour bits remain and all ingredients are combined.
6. Spoon the batter into the donut cavities.
7. Place the pan in the oven and bake for 8 to 10 minutes.
8. Remove from the oven and allow to cool in the pan before inverting onto a wire rack to cool.
9. While the donuts cool, make the glaze.
10. In a medium bowl whisk together the powdered sugar, vanilla extract and salt.
11. Add 1 tablespoon of milk, and whisk to combine. If the glaze is too thick, add additional milk, 1/2 teaspoons at a time until the desired consistency is reached.
12. Once the donuts are completely cool, dip them into the vanilla glaze. Return to wire rack and sprinkle with sprinkles. Allow the glaze to set for about 30 minutes before stacking and serving.
13. Enjoy these delicious vanilla glazed baked donuts!

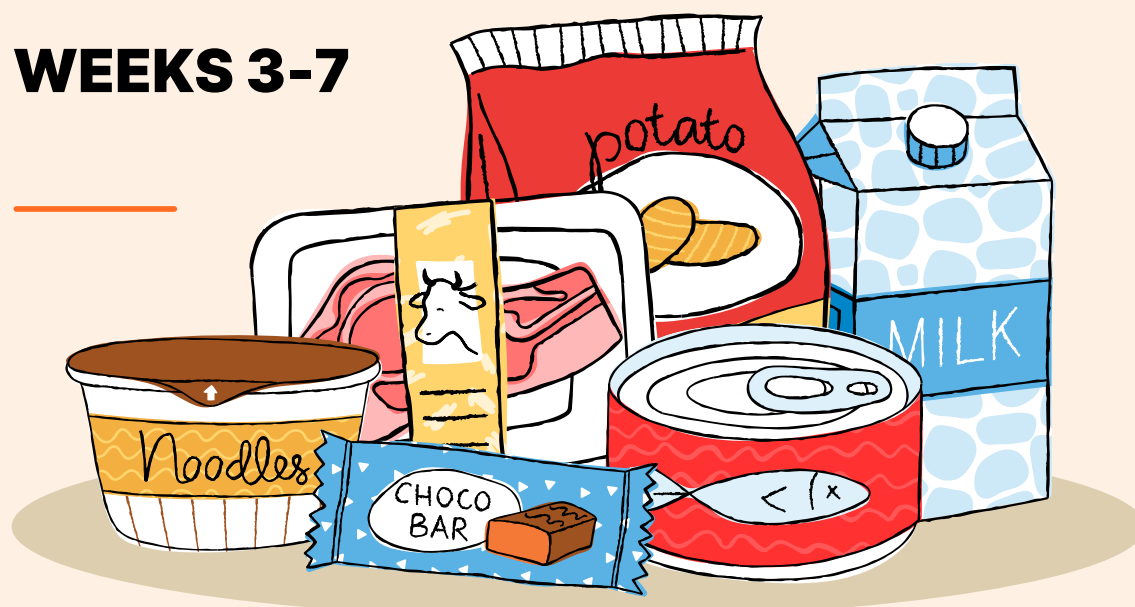
