Tuna, Kosher turkey or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

Rainbow Veggie Pinwheels

INGREDIENTS:

- 8 Flour Tortillas
- 2 cups whipped cream cheese
- 5 tablespoons ranch dressing
- 2 cups red pepper strips
- 2 cups carrot strips
- 2 cups yellow pepper strips
- 2 cups spinach leaves
- 2 cups purple cabbage



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Mix together the cream cheese and ranch dressing until thoroughly combined.
- 2. Spread the cream cheese mixture evenly over the flour tortillas.
- 3. Leaving a 1" border on all sides, layout 2 tablespoons of each vegetable in rows across the tortillas.
- 4. Roll up each tortilla tightly. If the ends do not stay shut you can add a little bit more cream cheese to seal. Cut into pinwheels and serve.

FRUITY PEBBLES CUPCAKES

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 eggs
- 1.5 cup sugar
- .75 cups butter
- 1.5 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2.25 cups All-purpose flour
- 2.25 teaspoon baking powder
- A pinch of salt
- .75 cups milk
- 0.5 cups rainbow sprinkles
- 1.5 cups butter
- 3.5 cups confectioners sugar
- 2 tablespoon heavy cream
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup fruity pebbles



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Line a standard 12- cup standard muffin tin with paper liners; set aside.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine flour, baking powder and salt.
- 3. In a medium bowl, whisk together milk, egg whites and vanilla.
- 4. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with paddle attachment, beat butter and eggs at medium speed until light an fluffy, about 2-3 minutes. With mixer on low speed, add dry ingredients and milk mixture alternately in 3 parts, beginning and ending with dry ingredients, beating just until incorporated. Add rainbow sprinkles and stir using rubber spatula just until moist.
- Scoop the batter evenly in to the muffin tray. Place into oven and bake for 15-18 minutes, or until tester inserted in center comes out clean. Remove from oven and cool completely on a wire rack before frosting.
- 6. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with paddle attachment, beat butter and confectioners' sugar on medium speed until light and fluffy, approximately 1-2 minutes. With the mixer on low speed, gradually add heavy cream and vanilla, beating just until incorporated. Increase speed to medium high and beat until frosting is light and fluffy, approximately 1-2 minutes
- Use a small offset spatula or a pastry bag fitted with a decorative tip to frost cupcakes, garnished with Fruity Pebbles.
