A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

BIUE BETTY CLEAW CHEESE COOPIES

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup of sugar
- 1/2 cups of butter
- 4 ounces of cream cheese
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon of lemon zest
- 2.5 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon of baking soda
- 2 teaspoon cornstarch
- 1/4 teaspoon of kosher salt
- 2 cups of blueberries
- 1 cup of powdered sugar
- 1 tablespoon cream cheese
- 1 tablespoon of lemon juice

DIRECTIONS:

- Make cookies: Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line two baking sheets wth parchment paper. In a large bowl, cream together sugar, butter, and cream cheese until fluffy. Scrape down sides, then add egg, lemon juice and zest. Beat until combined.
- 2. In a medium bowl, combine flour, baking soda, cornstarch, and salt. Beat into the wet mixture just until combined. Gently fold in blueberries.
- 3. Using a large cookie scoop, scoop dough (about 3 tbsp) onto prepared baking sheets. Bake until cookies are set and edges turn lightly golden, 10 to 15 minutes. Let cool.
- Meanwhile, make glaze: Whisk together powdered sugar, cream, lemon juice and zest. Drizzle on top of cookies.

Taco Pasta Salad

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 pound shells or rotini
- 16 ounces black beans, rinsed and drained
- 2 cups of corn
- 1/2 cup of cilantro
- 2 tomatoes, diced
- 1 1/2 cups of salsa
- 1/3 cups olive oil
- 1/4 cup lime juice
- 2 tablespoons taco seasoning
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- Salt and pepper
- 2 cups of Mexican blend cheese, shredded
- 3 avocados, diced

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cook pasta according to package directions. Drain and cool.
- 2. In a large bowl, add the cooled pasta, black beans, corn, cilantro, tomatoes, and salsa. Toss gently.
- In a small bowl, whisk together olive oil, lime juice, taco seasoning, and garlic. Pour over pasta and toss to coat. Add salt and pepper to taste. Chill until serving.
- Right before serving, toss in the cheese and avocado.
 Add your favorite taco toppings like sour cream or crushed tortillas chips.
