Tuna, Kosher turkey or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

# Chocolate Chip Muffins

We had a wonderful summer working with all of the amazing campers. We baked up some delicious treats and lifelong memories.

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 ½ teaspoon baking powder
- 1 pinch salt
- 1 large egg
- 1/2 cup (100g) granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup (120g) plain yogurt, full fat
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3/4 cup mini chocolate chips & more for sprinkling over the muffins.

#### **DIRECTIONS**:

- 1. Line a muffin pan with paper liners. Set aside. In a large bowl stir together flour, baking powder and salt and set aside.
- In a medium bowl, mix together egg and granulated sugar until combined. Pour in yogurt, vegetable oil (or melted butter, slightly cooled), and vanilla extract.
  - Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and whisk until combined.
- 3. Mix the mini chocolate chips with 1 Tablespoon flour in a bowl\*\*, then fold in the mini chocolate chips into the muffin batter and stir until evenly spread (do not overmix the batter).
- 4. Cover the bowl with a cloth and let the muffin batter sit at room temperature for 1 hour to give time to the baking powder to activate it's the key to tall and fluffy muffins, with an airy crumb.
- 5. Preheat the oven to 400°F, and carefully scoop the muffin batter into the muffin cavities up to the top. Add extra mini chocolate chips on top of each muffin\*\*\*.
- 6. Place muffins in the oven and reduce immediately the oven temperature 375°F (190°C). Bake for about 20 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool for 5 minutes in the pan then remove muffins and on a wire rack to cool completely. Enjoy!
