Mac and Cheese Grilled Cheese

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 box of macaroni and cheese
- 2 tbsp. butter (plus more for cooking)
- 1/4 cups milk
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese, divided
- 8 slices french bread



DIRECTIONS:

1. In a medium saucepan filled with boiling water, cook macaroni until al dente, about 7-8 minutes. Drain.
2. Melt 2 tablespoons of butter in the same pot over low heat. Add milk and cheese packet and whisk well. Turn off the heat and return macaroni. Add 1/2 to 1 cup of cheddar and stir until the cheddar is melted and the macaroni is evenly coated in the cheese sauce. Remove from heat.
3. Assemble sandwiches: Butter one side of each piece of bread. For each sandwich, place one slice of bread buttered side down on a clean working surface or plate. Cover bread with cheddar cheese, then spoon macaroni and cheese on top. Sprinkle with more cheddar than top with one more slice of bread, buttered side up. Repeat process with remaining bread.
4. Heat a large nonstick skillet over medium heat. Place 1 to 2 sandwiches (or however many will fit) in the skillet and cook until bread is golden and the cheese is melted, about 3 minutes per side.

S'MORES NO-BAKE COOKIES

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/4 cup butter
- 1 (10.5 oz) bag mini marshmallows
- 1 (11.5 oz) bag milk chocolate chips, plus (an optional) 1 cup chips for drizzling
- 8 cups Golden Graham cereal



DIRECTIONS:

1. Melt butter in a medium stockpot over medium heat. When melted, add in marshmallows, and stir frequently until melted. Remove from heat.
2. Stir in Golden Graham cereal until evenly coated. Add chocolate chips and continue stirring until evenly distributed. (If you would rather the chips not melt much, just freeze them beforehand.)
3. Use a spoon to shape mixture into small clumps and place on wax or parchment paper to cool.
4. For the optional drizzle, melt chocolate chips in a double-boiler or (carefully) in the microwave until melted. If the chocolate is too thick, stir in a teaspoon or two of shortening or vegetable oil to thin. Transfer melted chocolate to a pastry bag fitted with a small tip, and drizzle onto the cookies once they have cooled slightly. (If you do not have a pastry bag, you can also use a plastic freezer bag, and just snip off a tiny corner to drizzle.)
