From the Directors:

Can you believe that camp starts in 73 days? If you visit us during the off season you'll hear us say that we work "10 for 2". All of this is made possible by our camp families, and we want to thank all of our new and returning campers for joining us this summer. We know that there are lots of camps and the fact that you choose Eagle's Landing means so much to us.

If you're already enrolled, this is your reminder if you want to add or change any weeks for this summer. The sooner you let us know, the better your chance of getting the weeks that you want. We only have about 40 spots left in the entire camp and certain grades are



completely closed due to full camper enrollment.

You've received a few emails regarding your camper forms. We need them to create a safe and enjoyable summer for everyone! If you have any

remaining overdue forms, submit them no later than April 25 in order for your child to come to camp. If you have not finished, please take a moment to fill out your paperwork. The Camper Profile Form is helpful when it comes to knowing your child, whether they are returning or new to camp. Ruth Ann reads every form along with your child's Division Leader (the teacher who oversees their division). Children grow and change during the year, so it's important they start off with a clean slate every summer. The Health History Form is also due April 25 so that our Nurses have time to review the information. NJ State Law prohibits any child from coming to camp without the completed form.

Now that the sun is out, camp has become a busy place. We love watching the tents go up! We're also busy cutting the grass, painting buildings, fixing doors and roofs, and so much more! Every day we get truckloads of packages full of camp supplies from paint for Arts and Crafts to new soccer balls for Sports. We also love

getting visitors at camp! We're here 7 days a week so feel free to stop by and say hello, play outside, meet a friend that's coming to camp with you, or just to hang out. All we ask is that you pop your head into the office and let us know that you're on the property and then go have some fun! We're bringing back both Chicken and Vegetarian Empanadas, and we added a new Vegetarian Chili lunch! Don't worry, you'll see all of the fan favorites like Grilled Cheese and Pizza as well.

Our salad bar has plenty of fresh-made salads prepared by our cooks. Our famous vegetarian Black Bean Taco Salad is also available as a wrap. Every day we have two 6' salad bars end-to-end fully loaded with healthy options and fresh fruit (plus the grilled cheese croutons)! We continue to update the salad bar offerings for popularity and make adjustments throughout the

CELL PHONE POLICY

The Eagle's Landing policy regarding cell phones and technology has NOT changed and we need your help to enforce this rule. We ask any parent whose child has a cell phone, no matter the age of the camper, to ensure their phone is left at home. The only cell phones permitted on the property are for campers who have medical concerns and use their phone as a monitor. Coming to camp means socializing and spending time with friends and talking to them without screens. We do not allow texting, use of a connected watch, or taking pictures of other campers. If we find a phone on your camper or in their backpack, we will take the phone and ask you to come to the camp office to pick it up after the camp day is over. Please help us help your kids and keep that screen at home. Recent studies show that children who use screens before the age of 5 demonstrate developmental delays.

Our staff are required to follow the same guidelines regarding phones or they are terminated.

Check This Out

We often have parents asking for a good podcast or book recommendations about children. We understand, because being a parent in today's world meets with countless challenges. In the age of "everybody else has it" and "please put your phone away", we thought we would share some of the books and podcasts we tune into.

Sending your child to camp is important for their social and emotional health. Ruth Ann gets lots of phone calls from parents describing how their child struggles to make friends, or how their child always has a screen in

their hand, so how does camp help them? Scan here for an article fom the American Camp Association about the benefit of detaching from electronics for the summer →

Camp gives every child the opportunity to experience face-to-face interactions, build relationships, practice emotional



regulation, build self-esteem, and benefit from reduced screen time. The Eagle's Landing program is designed to increase physical activity, imagination, creativity, problem-solving, critical thinking, and improve sleep. There's lots of information out there sharing why we do what we do here at camp. If you want to learn more, we recommend the book *The Anxious Generation:* How the Great Rewiring of Childhood Is Causing an Epidemic of Mental Illness by Jonathon Haidt. If you are not a reader, we highly recommend Dax Shepard's podcast Arm Chair Expert; specifically the episode with Jonathon Haidt returning to discuss his book *The Anxious Generation*.
