A healthy, whole grain snack is available every morning. Ice cream or ices and fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains trans fats.



Strawberry French Toast Roll-Ups

Ingredients:

8 slices sandwich bread, crusts removed

1/4 cup whipped cream cheese 1 cup strawberries, diced 2 eggs

3 tablespoon vanilla extract

2 tablespoons butter, for cooking 2 tablespoons sugar

1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon



Instructions:

- 1. On a flat surface, flatten sandwich bread with a rolling pin.
- 2. Spread 1 1/2 teaspoons of cream cheese onto each slice of bread.
- 3. Place 1 tablespoon of diced strawberries along the edge of each piece of bread.
- 4. Carefully, roll up bread lightly.
- 5. In a shallow dish, beat eggs, milk and vanilla.
- 6. Dip each bread roll in the egg mixture and places 3-4 of them in a butter greased skillet, over medium head, seam down.
- 7. Cook 3 minutes until golden brown and flip.
- 8. Cook other side for an additional 1-2 minutes and remove from the pan.
- 9. In a shallow dish, combine sugar and cinnamon.
- 10. As french toast rolls come out of the pan, lightly dust with cinnamon sugar and serve.

2 large eggs, 1 cup granulated sugar, 1/2 cup of butter, 1 teaspoon vanilla extract, 1 1/2 cups flour, 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder, A pinch of salt, 1/2 cup milk **Frosting:**

4 1/2 cups powdered sugar, 1/2 cup butter, 2 1/4 teaspoons vanilla extract, 3 tablespoons milk **Instructions for cupcakes**:

- 1. Line a muffin pan with cupcake liners and preheat oven to 350° F
- 2. Beat together eggs and granulated sugar
- 3. Add softened butter and vanilla to eggs and sugar then mix until creamy
- 4. In a separate bowl, sift together flour, baking powder and salt
- 5. Add ingredients in step 4 into ingredients from step 3 then add milk and mix well
- 6. Scoop cupcake batter into the lined muffin pan, filling each cupcake about 2/3rds of the way
- 7. Place an ice cream cone upside down on batter in each cup
- 8. Bake 16 to 22 minutes (or until inserted toothpick comes out dry)
- 9. Cool completely then remove paper baking cups

10. Frost each cupcake generously and decorate as desired.

Instructions for frosting:

- 1. Put all the ingredients in a large bowl
- 2. Mix well
