What to Bring and Leave at Camp

Please send the following items with your child every day in their backpack. Please clearly print their name on the tag provided on the back of the backpack:

- two bathing suits (wear one to camp)
- shorts
- underwear
- two towels
- plastic bag for wet clothing

Please apply sunscreen to your camper each morning. Counselors in grades KK through 5 will automatically reapply sunscreen to campers after each swim. If you want sunscreen reapplied to an older camper, send in a note via Bus Mail.

Campers in Kiddie Kingdom will also receive a bag, which we call a *Bundle Bag*, to hold their additional items that stay at camp. This bag will be in your child's backpack. Please include the following items in addition to what will stay in their cubby:

- bathing suit
- extra sunscreen
- a complete change for clothing including underwear, socks, t-shirt, and shorts

Churro Cupcakes

INGREDIENTS:

Cupcake Batter

2 cups flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 cup butter, softened

1 3/4 cup sugar

4 eggs

1/2 cup milk

1 teaspoon vanilla

Buttercream Frosting

1/2 cup butter, softened

6 cups powdered sugar

1/4 cup milk

2 teaspoons vanilla

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Cinnamon Sugar Topping

3 tablespoons sugar

2 teaspoons ground cinnamon

Churros (optional for garnish)

DIRECTIONS:

Cupcakes

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°
- 2. Combine flour, baking powder, ground cinnamon and salt
- 3. In a large mixing bowl, beat butter on medium for 30 seconds, add sugar 1/4 cup at a time, beating on medium until combined
- 4. Add eggs, milk, and vanilla, mix until combined
- 5. Add in flour mixture and mix until well combined
- 6. Fill cup cupcake liners about 2/3 of the way full with cupcake batter then bake in the oven for 18-20 minutes
- 7. When the cupcakes are done, let them cool then put on frosting and cinnamon sugar topping. You can also garnish the cupcake with a piece of a churro.

Frosting

In a large mixing bowl beat butter on medium until smooth then add powdered sugar, milk and vanilla. Mix until smooth then add cinnamon and mix until everything is well combined.

Cinnamon Sugar Topping

Mix together cinnamon and sugar until well combined.

Omelette Breakfast Egg Bites

INGREDIENTS:

4 eggs
1/2 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon olive oil
1/4 cup milk
salt and pepper
8 oz shredded cheese
1 bell pepper
1/2 white onion



DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut up all of your veggies. You can add in any additional toppings you might want like mushrooms, tomatoes or meats.

- 2. Heat up a tablespoon of olive oil and sauté your veggies for about 7-8 minutes.
- 3. In a mixing bowl, combine your 4 eggs, baking powder, olive oil and milk. Add a pinch of salt and pepper.
- 4. Spray your muffin pan with non-stick spray and add your cooked veggie mixture first. Next add your shredded cheese and finally add your egg mixture. Fill to the top of the muffin tin, but don't overfill.
- 5. Bake in the oven at 375 for about 20 minutes. You can stick a toothpick in to make sure the eggs are cooked.
- 6. Let cool for 5 minutes before eating, and enjoy
