Snickerdoodles

G3Besties

INGREDIENTS:

1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened
1/2 cup granulated sugar
1/3 cup light brown sugar, packed
1 large egg
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 1/2 cup all purpose flour
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar
1/4 teaspoon salt, optional and to taste



For Rolling

1/4 granulated sugar
2 teaspoons cinnamon

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. To the bowl of a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment (or large mixing bowl and electric mixer) combine the butter, sugars, and beat on medium-high speed until creamed and well combined, about 3 minutes.
2. Scrape down the sides of the bowl, and add the egg, vanilla, and beat on medium-high speed until well combined, light and fluffy, about 3 minutes.
3. Scrape down the sides of the bowl, and add the flour, baking soda, cream of tartar, optional salt, and beat on low speed until just combined, about 1 minute.
4. Using a medium 2-inch scoop or your hands, form approximately 14 equal-sized mounds of dough (2 heaping tablespoons each), roll into balls and flatten slightly.
5. Place mounds on a large plate or tray, cover with plastic wrap, and refrigerate for at least 1 hour, up to 5 days. Do not bake dough unchilled or cookies will be thinner, flatter, and more prone to spreading.
6. Preheat oven to 350°F and spray with cooking spray. For Rolling- In a small bowl, combine sugar, cinnamon, and stir to combine.
7. Dredge each mound of dough through cinnamon-sugar.
8. Place dough mounds on baking sheet, and bake for about 9 minutes, or until edges have set and tops are just set, even if slightly undercooked, pale, and glossy in the center; don't over bake for soft, pillowy cookies. For firmer cookies, bake a minute or two longer. Cookies firm up as they cool.

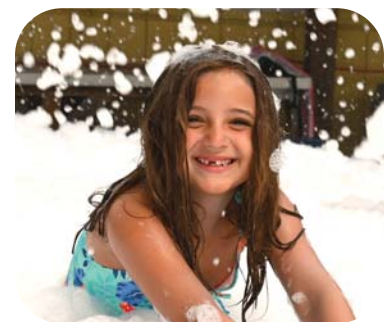
