Tuna, Kosher turkey, black bean wraps, or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) are always available.

A snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian, halal, vegan, and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

Pizza Oatmeal

INGREDIENTS:

2 tbsp. olive oil
1 yellow onion, diced
4 cloves of garlic, sliced
1 cup quick-cooking oats
1 cup old fashioned oats
1 28 oz can peeled tomatoes
1/2 tsp ground black pepper
1 tsp Italian seasoning
1 tsp salt
1 tbsp granulated sugar
4 cups water
shredded mozzarella and grated Parmesan for topping



DIRECTIONS:

1. Heat oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add onion and garlic and stir until fragrant and onion turns lightly golden, 4-5 minutes. Add oats and stir constantly until toasty, about 3 minutes
2. Add tomatoes, Italian seasoning, salt and sugar and stir until well combined. Use a wooden spoon to break up tomatoes into bite sized chunks. Stir in water and bring to a simmer.
3. Reduce heat to medium-low and cook until thickened and creamy, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking and burning on the bottom of the pot, 10-12 minutes.
4. Top with desired cheeses while hot and garnish with more olive oil and basil before serving.

CHOCOLATE CHIP BLONDIES

INGREDIENTS:

- 3/4 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup butter, melted
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/4 tsp baking powder
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1/2 cup semisweet chocolate chips



DIRECTIONS:

1. In a large bowl, combine the brown sugar, butter, eggs, and vanilla just until blended. Combine the flour, baking powder and salt; add to brown sugar mixture. Stir in chocolate chips
2. Spread into a greased 13-in. x 9-in. baking pan. Bake at 350°F for 18-20 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack. Cut into bars.
