Our salad bar includes fresh mixed greens, grape tomatoes, tofu, cucumbers, hard boiled eggs, pasta salad, granola, chickpeas, farro salad, edamame, fresh fruit, applesauce, shredded cheese, non-fat fruit yogurt, lo mein salad, black bean taco salad, corn, and assorted dressings.

Tuna, Kosher turkey, or SunButter and jelly sandwiches on whole wheat bread or whole wheat bagels with cream cheese or margarine (dairy free) and black bean wraps are always available.

A snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

COOKIES & CREAM CAKE BATTER BARS

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 large eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- ½ cup butter
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 ½ cups flour
- 1 ½ tsp baking powder
- pinch of salt
- ½ cup milk
- 1 cup white chocolate chips
- 1 cup crushed Oreos
- 1 cup crushed Circus Animal Cookies



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Grease a 9x13-inch pan.
2. Combine eggs and sugar in a large mixing bowl, once combined, add softened butter, milk and vanilla. Mix until creamy
3. In a small bowl, sift together flour, baking powder and salt
4. Add the dry ingredients into wet ingredients, mix well.
5. Fold or gently mix in white chocolate chips and both crushed cookies until just combined.
6. Pour batter into prepared pan.
7. Bake for 17-20 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean when poked through the center.

Grilled Cheese Pancakes

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 1/2 cups all purpose flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp kosher salt
- 1 tbsp kosher salt
- 1 tbsp granulated sugar
- 1 cup plus 2 tbsp milk
- 1/4 cup sour cream
- 1 large egg
- 3 tbsp melted butter plus more for pan
- 1 cup shredded cheddar
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella
- 1/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan
- Coarsely ground black pepper
- 2 tbsp mayonnaise
- Maple syrup, for serving
- Crumbled bacon, for garnish



DIRECTIONS:

1. In a large bowl, whisk together, flour, baking powder, salt and sugar, in a medium bowl, whisk to combine milk, sour cream, egg and melted butter. Gently fold dry ingredients into wet ingredients until just combined.
2. In a large skillet over medium heat, melt 1/2 tablespoon butter. Pour a scant 1/3 cup pancake batter into pan twice to make two pancakes. When little bubbles appear, about 3 to 4 minutes, flip one pancake and top with 1/3 cheddar, 1/4 cup mozzarella, 1 tablespoon Parmesan, and a pinch black pepper. Flip remaining pancake. Continue cooking until second side is golden and cheese is melted, 3 minutes more.
3. Top cheesy pancake with a plain pancake, then evenly spread 1/2 tablespoon mayonnaise onto top pancake. Flip and cook until a golden crust forms, 1 minute. Spread 1/2 tablespoon mayonnaise on to the second side, then flip to cook until a golden crust forms, 1 minute more. Transfer sandwich to a plate.
4. Repeat with remaining batter, cheeses, and mayonnaise.
5. Serve with maple syrup and garnish with bacon, if desired.
