A snack is available every morning. Ice cream, ices, pretzels or fresh fruit are served as a snack in the afternoon.

Special dietary concerns including Kosher, gluten free, Halal, vegetarian and food allergies can be accommodated.

Eagle's Landing is "Peanut Aware." All of our food is free of nut derivatives, including peanuts. All of our food is baked or grilled. Nothing is fried or contains no trans fats.

Cookies 4 Cream Dessert Cups

INGREDIENTS:

Chocolate Cookie Crust -2 cups crushed chocolate

- sandwich cookies
- -¼ cup butter, melted
 Cookies and Cream Filling
- -8 oz cream cheese, room temperature
- -34 cup sugar
- -2 tsp vanilla extract
- -1 ½ cups heavy whipping cream
- -½ cup crushed Oreo's Garnish
- -28 mini Oreo's

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a small bowl, combine 2 cups chocolate sandwich cookie crumbs and melted butter.
- 2. Portion the crumbs into 28 2-ounce plastic cups using a small cookie scoop or spoon, press the crumbs into the bottom of the cup.
- 3. In another mixing bowl, combine room temperature cream cheese and granulated sugar. Cream together with an electric hand mixer on medium speed until combined and smooth.
- 4. Add in heavy whipping cream and vanilla extract. Whip on medium-high speed until light and fluffy.
- 5. Fold in ½ cup crushed Oreo's.
- 6. Put the mixture into the cups until about 3/4 full.
- 7. Top each dessert cup with a mini Oreo
- 8. Seal the cups with a lid and chill. The cups can be served immediately or stored in the refrigerator for 2-3 days.
