Apple Pie Bites

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 cans crescent rolls
- 2 cans apple pie filling
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- 4 teaspoons sugar



DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 375°F. Coat muffin tin with baking spray
2. Unroll and pull apart crescent rolls, placing one triangle of dough in each muffin tin.
3. Add one heaping spoonful of apple pie filling on top of each crescent roll.
4. Mix together the cinnamon and sugar, sprinkle a little over the pie filling.
5. Pull the edges of the crescent rolls up and over the pie filling
6. Sprinkle a little more of the cinnamon sugar mixture on the dough of each pie.
7. Bake for about 15 minutes, until golden brown. Allow to cool slightly and serve warm.

NO-BAKE DIRT CUPS

INGREDIENTS:

Chocolate Cookie Crust
- 1/4 cup unsalted butter, melted
- 2 cups crushed Oreos

Chocolate Mousse Filling
- 3.9 oz instant chocolate pudding mix
- 1 1/2 cups milk
- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream



Topping
- 1 cup crushed Oreos
- 28 gummy worms

DIRECTIONS:

1. In a small bowl, combine Oreo crumbs and melted butter. Mix to combine.
2. Portion the crumbs into 28 2-ounce plastic cups using a small cookie scoop or spoon.
3. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together instant chocolate pudding mix and milk until combined. Chill for 5 minutes.
4. Pour heavy whipping cream into the pudding and whip on medium-high speed with an electric hand mixer until thickened.
5. Scoop the mixture into cups until about 3/4 full
6. Spoon Oreo crumbs over the chocolate mousse.
7. Add gummy worms to the top of the dessert cups.
8. Depending on the size of the worms, you may need to cut them in half if they are too large.
9. Seal the cups with a lid and chill. The cups can be served immediately or stored in the refrigerator for 2 to 3 days.
